" I was most sorry for the outcome of the war, but I had done my best. I let my troops execute the President's final order for themselves. I had nothing more to say. But deep in my heart, I silently thanked all of them for their courage, sacrifice, and dedication until the very last of the war. Together, we had fulfilled our obligation and oath of allegiance."

" I shall never repent having done what I did, nor complain about the consequences of my captivity. If history were to repeat itself, I would choose the same path. By doing so, I know from experience that I would lose everything but HONOR"
