Kyle Andrew Heflin of Bristow, Virginia died April 17th, 2010 at his home.

Kyle was born at Prince William Hospital on April 7, 1986.

It was good that he was born in Spring because his personality was just like the season, sunny and optimistic. Kyle loved hiking and camping, playing his X-box, and being with his friends. He was loyal to a fault and never seemed to meet a stranger; he made new friends in only minutes after meeting someone.

Kyle's brothers and sister all considered him the smartest. When he learned there was no chess team at Osbourn High School he got friends together and formed a club, of which he served as vice president.

Kyle was a creative person and enjoyed art, particularly drawing. Kyle couldn't sing a bit but that didn't stop him from loving music and he always had something playing. He traveled all over the United States and internationally, with a trip throughout Europe as a student in the People to People Ambassador Program, and then vacations to Russia, the Caribbean, and South America. Because of his travels, life experiences, and education he conversed on many

subjects but always with a kind of humility that drew people to him. He had a great sense of humor, a very sharp wit and loved both to laugh and to make people laugh. Kyle worked hard in all he did and was currently employed at Wegmans Lake Manassas.
