LANCE RONALD HANSON, 60 of Manassas, Virginia died Friday, June 10, 2005 at his home surrounded by his family, after a lengthy battle with cancer.

Mr. Hanson majored in vocal music at Millikin University. He served in the U. S. Navy as a member of the Sea Chanters, their premier vocal group, based in Washington, D.C. He became a police officer in Estes Park, Colorado, later returning to Virginia, where he worked for United Parcel Service for 19 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents Herbert and Betty Klaus Hanson.
