January 11, 1951 - February 9, 2025

Larry Parker Greene, 74, of Fairfax, VA, passed away on February 9, 2025. He was born on January 11, 1951, to Henry Parker Greene and Lucretia Elizabeth Davis Greene in Manassa, VA.

Larry, affectionally known as "Popcorn," attended Eleven Oaks Elementary, Robert Frost Intermediate, and Fairfax High Schools in Fairfax, VA. After high school, he worked with Old Virginia City, driving a stagecoach and a covered wagon for children. At 18, he worked for the Fairfax County Department of Solid Waste for two years. On February 26, 1971, he was drafted into the U.S. Marine Corps and served his country for six years. After being discharged with honor, Larry returned to work for the Fairfax County Department of Solid Waste until his retirement in 2015.

He accepted Christ at an early age at Mount Zoar Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Pastor Clinton L. Rogers. He continued serving the Lord with the successor, Rev Dr. Spencer F. Isaac of New Mount Zoar Baptist Church, until he was called to his eternal home. He was preceded in death by his father, Trustee Henry Parker Greene; mother, Deaconess Lucretia Elizabeth Greene; sister, Vanessa Greene; grandparents, Frederick and Laura Greene; Marie Davis; and several uncles and aunts.

He was a father, brother, husband, and son who demonstrated care for others

and being there when it mattered. Even when he wasn't feeling well, he always put others first, readily helping family and friends without complaining – his kindness and generosity are truly inspiring. He was a fighter and never gave up in any situation, and no matter what, he looked out for his family and those closest to him when they needed him. He always said the happiest moments of his life were when his family gathered together. Larry tried to see the light in any situation, even when others couldn't.

Larry loved the outdoors. His hobbies included football, fishing, hunting, and working on cars. He always found peace by the water. His spirit lives on in the stillness of the lake, while his love for fishing will always be a cherished memory, like a big catch on a perfect day. Larry was also a sports fan. His favorite football team was the Dallas Cowboys, and it made his day when they would beat Washington (Red Skins) 😊

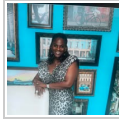
