Larry Olyn Page, 85, of Manassas, Virginia passed away peacefully on December 27, 2021. He was born August 3, 1936 in Pennsylvania and later moved to Northern Virginia with his family. He was a member of the United States Air Force from 1955-1959 as an Airman First Class. After his service, he became a computer programmer for the United States Government for over 38 years. After his retirement, he proudly served Prince William County as a school bus driver for over 12 years. He was an active, founding member and deacon of Westover Baptist Church and most recently an active member and deacon of Manassas Baptist Church.
