



Larry "Pat" Patrick Peavley

Larry Patrick Peavley, 60, of Broad Run, Virginia, passed away on December 23, 2018, at Inova Fairfax Hospital surrounded with love by his wife, Joy, and daughter Skylar.

Pat was born in Welch, West Virginia, on October 25, 1958, to the late Joseph Patrick Morgan and Naomi Regina Peavley. He was raised in Big Four and graduated from Welch High School in 1976, where he played football and was involved in student government. He attended West Virginia University, in Morgantown, where he began what was to become a remarkably successful career in banking and finance.

Pat was CEO of McLean Mortgage, and was an industry leader in the Washington, DC, area for more than 30 years. Pat strategically guided several companies to extraordinary success through his uncommon common sense, competitive nature and his sincere, open and winning personality. In addition to his works of philanthropy, Pat mentored many people, and helped instill in so many the self-confidence and marketable skills needed for successful careers.

He was well-loved and respected by many people, who found him unfailingly caring, selfless and genuine. Pat genuinely liked and believed in people and, in turn, people wanted to be around Pat. He loved Mountaineer sports, good

bourbon, golf, being with friends, meeting new people, and listening to Lynyrd Skynyrd and Little Feat. He was loyal, funny, smart, optimistic and real. There was no pretense about Pat.
