Larry Dean Wood, age 73, of Manassas, VA met our Heavenly Father on Wednesday, January 16, 2019 at the Prince William Medical Center.

*This news makes us very sad! We have such fond memories of all the time our families spent together back in the 1960s and 1970s. We just want you to know how much we love you all, and we pray that God will wrap His arms around all of you and help you feel His love, presence, and comfort in the difficult days ahead. We also want you to know that it breaks our hearts that we will not be able to attend Larry's funeral. Unfortunately, we both just got out of the hospital. Tommy had a total knee replacement on December 18 and ended up back in the hospital on December 23 for an additional week as they worked to get his heart rhythm under control (his defibrillator started shocking him). I managed to fall twice in four days (December 20 and December 24), fracturing both collar bones, 3 ribs, and multiple areas in my pelvis and sacrum. I spent a week in the hospital and two weeks in a rehab facility. Needless to say, we're not moving around too well. Please know that we love you and would be there if we could.*
