Lee Anita Burnham passed away Tuesday, November 9, 2021, at her home in Gainesville, Virginia, surrounded by her loving family. She was born in Provo, Utah on January 21, 1954, graduated from Provo High School in 1972, and received a bachelor's degree in microbiology from Brigham Young University. She later received a second bachelor's degree from the University of Utah in medical technology. She moved to the Washington DC area in 1985 and has lived in Gainesville since 2003. She was a staunch advocate of inclusive education for children with developmental disabilities and was passionate about family history research.
