LESLIE ANN COLLINS, age 52 of Manassas, Virginia passed away on Tuesday, November 29, 2005 at Georgetown University Hospital after surviving six years with advanced breast cancer and 15 years overall.

Leslie was born March 28, 1953 in Brownsville, Pennsylvania. Leslie graduated at the top of her class as a Medical Technologist from California University of Pennsylvania and worked for 12 years in Norfolk, Virginia. For the last nine years she was the dearly loved Christian Educator at Manassas Presbyterian Church where she coordinated Sunday School and passed out treats in her office. Her favorite activity was Vacation Bible School, where her skills in planning and elaborate set design brought joy to hundreds of children.
