



Lewis Alma Carroll Jr.

Lewis Alma Carroll, Jr., a devoted family man and respected community member, passed away peacefully on August 23, 2024, at the age of 84. Born on November 13, 1939, in Geneva, Alabama, Lewis was the beloved son of Lewis Alma Carroll, Sr. and Ethel Mae Sutton, both of Holmes County, Florida. Lewis spent his early years in Holmes County, Florida, before moving to Crossville, Tennessee, where he would build a life filled with hard work, faith, and love for his family. In 1968, he began a successful career in the service station industry, operating Phillips 66, Exxon/Mobil, and Sunoco stations, where he earned a reputation for his integrity and dedication.

A proud veteran, Lewis served two years in the United States Air Force, where he demonstrated the values of service and commitment that he carried throughout his life. On January 4, 1964, he married the love of his life, Bonnye Carol Butcher. Together, they shared 57 wonderful years of marriage until her passing in June 2021. Lewis was also a devoted grandfather to his 11 grandchildren, who brought him immense joy and pride.

Lewis was a man of deep faith and strong character, known for his willingness to lend a hand to anyone in need. His warm smile and kind heart made him a beloved figure in the community, especially at his favorite place, Cracker Barrel, where he was known and loved by all.

In his free time, Lewis enjoyed working in his yard on his Kubota tractor,

finding peace and satisfaction in maintaining his land. But above all, he cherished the time spent with his grandchildren and family, who were the center of his world.

Lewis is survived by his three sons and their families: Steven and Michelle, along with their children Brock, Brodie, and Lanie; David, with his children Cole, Connor, Copeland, Caris, Carsen, and Caylen; and Jonathan and Jolie, with their children Samantha and Griffin. He is also survived by his brother Max and sister June. Lewis was predeceased by his parents, Lewis Alma Carroll, Sr. and Ethel Mae Sutton, as well as his siblings Lowery, Charles, and Sue.

A service to celebrate Lewis's life will be held on Sunday, September 1, at Park Valley Church. Visitation will begin at 3:30 PM, followed by the service at 4:30 PM, with a reception to follow.
