



Lewis Sterling (Buddy) Newman

December 6, 1943 - November 13, 2023

Lewis Sterling (Buddy) Newman, III, (79), died in Manassas, Virginia on November 13, 2023, with family at his side. Lewis, who was known as “Buddy” to friends and family, and as “P” to his grandchildren, is survived by his wife of 56 years, Audry McKendree Newman, sister, Candace Chitty of Winter Park, Florida, daughter Kimberly (Martha Brown) of Manassas, son Andrew (Jane Nathanson) of Philadelphia, and four grandchildren, Andrew Newman-Brown (14) and Isabel Newman-Brown (11) of Manassas, and Lily Newman (9) and Jacob Newman (6) of Philadelphia. He was predeceased by his parents, Lewis and Floree Newman.

Lewis was born December 6, 1943, in Jacksonville, Florida, where he lived until moving to Tallahassee to attend Florida State University. In 1967, he married his childhood sweetheart, Audry, and relocated to the Washington, DC area to begin a 49-year career in national security. During that time, he worked for the Department of the Navy, the Federal Energy Administration, the Department of Energy, and several private consulting firms. In 2000, while continuing to work part-time, he and Audry moved back to Florida to help care for his aging parents. They lived in Fernandina Beach from 2000 until December 2016, at which time they returned to Northern Virginia to be closer to their children and grandchildren.

Lewis enjoyed a variety of outdoor interests throughout his life, including

sailing, fishing, running, and bicycling. He was active in various ministries of the parishes to which he and Audry belonged over the years. He was also an avid family historian and leaves his heirs a trove of ancestral research and artifacts.

A Funeral Mass is planned for November 29, 2023, at noon, at All Saints Catholic Church in Manassas, Virginia. The deceased remains will be interred in the Place of Peace Columbarium on grounds of the Benedictine Monastery in Bristow, Virginia following the funeral mass.
