Lewis Franklin Weaver, Jr., age 61 of Nokesville, Virginia, died at his residence on Saturday, October 26, 2013, after a long illness.

Mr. Weaver was born on October 16, 1952 to the late Lewis Franklin Weaver, Sr. and Georgia Marie (Street) Weaver of Manassas, Virginia.

Lewis was the ultimate outdoorsman! He instilled his love for hunting, fishing, and playing sports in both of his sons--he loved fishing and hunting the most, but also loved playing sports...football, basketball, baseball, and softball. He also had a love for motorcycles and was known in the Manassas area for one of the best "riders" around. In later years, Lewis developed an interest in vegetable gardening. This interest was passed down from his parents, Lewis and Marie Weaver who were the "ultimate" gardeners for many years. Lewis was a lifelong resident of the Manassas area and had many close friends. At times, it seemed like he knew everyone in Prince William County.

Survivors include his loving wife, Corrine R. (Hopkins) Weaver, his two sons, Brandon Lewis Weaver and Justin Lewis Weaver, grandson Blake Weaver of Nokesville, Virginia, his sisters Brenda Garner and husband Larry of Littleton, North Carolina and Jean Dolby of Leesburg, Virginia and many nieces and nephews.
