Linda Park Probst "Nana", age 84, of Mineral, passed away peacefully, surrounded by her family, on Sunday morning, February 1, 2026.

Linda was born on June 2, 1941, on the island of Oahu, Hawaii as the daughter of the late Milton Ayung Park and Elizabeth Rio Castaldo. At 6 months of age, while living on Oahu, she lived through the attack on Pearl Harbor.

She was preceded in death by her husband of 55 years, Donald (Don) Probst; her sister Penny Archer; and her brother Jerry Castaldo. She is survived by her son Dennis (wife Debbie); son Jon; 8 grandchildren (Justin, Tabatha, Kassidy, Kody, Grace, Paige, Skyler, and Jonas); and 3 great grandsons (Jordan, Salim, and Otis).

Linda graduated from Northwestern High School in Maryland. She worked for the Federal Government in Washington D.C for more than 30 years. During her career she was employed by the Department of the Navy, the Federal Aviation Administration, where she met her husband Don, the Department of the Interior, and the Department of Veterans Affairs. She was a member of the Laureate Beta Upsilon Chapter of the Beta Sigma Phi International Sorority since 1969. She was an avid league bowler. After retiring, she and Don moved from their home in Springfield to Lake Anna, where they enjoyed

fishing, boating, and spending time with family.
