



## Lossie Ballengee

September 28, 1922 - February 3, 2005

LOSSIE CARMAN BALLENGEE, age 82 of Front Royal, Virginia formerly of Haymarket died Thursday, February 3, 2005 at Heritage Hall, Leesburg.

Mr. Ballengee was a member of Haymarket Baptist Church for over 40 years and a life member of DAV Chapter 15, Manassas. He was chairman for Polar Bear Association, 339th Infantry Regiment. He was a U.S. Army Veteran having served during World War II in Africa and Italy and was wounded three times in war, one being May 12, 1944 in Tremonsoli, Italy. Mr. Ballengee was awarded two Oak Leaf Clusters, The Purple Heart, The Bronze and Silver Star and in 1994 went to Italy (Rome) for liberation of Rome for the 50th year anniversary celebration. Mr. Ballengee enjoyed gardening and loved his grandchildren, great-grandchildren and animals.

He was preceded in death by his loving wife of 53 years, Eula Jean Ballengee and three grandchildren.
