Lowell Vernon Edwards, 84, a devout Christian from Manassas, Virginia, returned to God on June 25, 2024. He was a beloved husband, father, grandfather, and friend who will be deeply missed by all who knew him.

Born on January 14, 1940, in Washington DC, Lowell led a life marked by unwavering commitment to his family, community, and faith. As soon as he could get a work permit, he worked for his father at Airport Transport located at DCA and acquired his interest in airplanes while hanging around the airport. He joined the Air Force Reserves and was stationed at Andrews Air Force base. Later he joined United Airlines and Northwest Orient as a Sales Agent. In 1970, he made a pivotal move with his wife, Diana, relocating their family to Manassas to join a new program offered by Goodyear to take a failing company store, take ownership and create your own success. Through hard work and determination, Lowell and Diana expanded their business in 1982 to include motorcycles, opening Manassas Honda, which became a cherished part of the community.

A man of profound faith, Lowell and his family were active members of Emmanuel Baptist Church for over two decades before transitioning to Centreville Baptist Church. Lowell found great joy in sharing his faith and participated in church activities, particularly relishing his time in the choir and sharing his love of God thru song.

Lowell met the love of his life, Diana Richards, at Pennsylvania Avenue Baptist Church at the age of 14 and they were married in January 1959. For 65 years their love endured and shared three children together, three grandchildren, and the great joy of great-grandchildren.

Lowell was preceded in death by his parents, Robert and Edna Edwards, his son Lowell Jr, and his brother Wayne.
