April 6, 1952 - February 5, 2021

Lynn Marie Karpiak Turley went to sleep in the Lord peacefully at Prince William County Medical Center on Friday February 5th in Manassas, Virginia at the age of 68.

Lynn Marie is survived by her husband James Richard Turley (Manassas Virginia); children, Danielle Marie Turley (Washington DC), Kyra Lynn Turley (Thibodaux, Louisiana), Christopher Owen Turley Sr. and spouse Alissa Anne Turley (Aldie, Virginia); grandchildren, Lauren Michelle Czerniak, Christopher Owen Turley Jr., Bradley James Turley. Chris and Alissa Turley are expecting child number 3, grandchild number 4, in July 2021. Lynn Marie is preceded in death by her parents Joseph Karpiak and Rebecca Fessick Karpiak.

Lynn Marie was born on April 6th, 1952 in Jersey City New Jersey to Joseph and Rebecca Karpiak. She graduated from St. Peter's College (now University) in 1974 with a degree in psychology. She continued her education at Seton Hall University where she earned her nursing degree. She married James R. Turley her college sweetheart in February 1974. After moving to Manassas Virginia in 1989, Lynn Marie worked at various hospital positions, generally in the labor and delivery departments. She ended her nursing career as a member of the Prince William County Health Department as a Registered Nurse. During her 20+ years of service with the health department she supported the local community and school systems providing health services

and education to community stakeholders. Lynn Marie will be remembered as a Loving and Caring Wife, Supportive and Protective Mother and Doting and Encouraging Mom-Mom.

Lynn Marie was always a woman quick to laugh at a joke, always ready to roll up her sleeves to work and unendingly dedicated to furthering the health and well being of those in the community. She will be missed greatly by those who came into contact with her in both her personal and professional life.

She was an active and dedicated member of the Manassas Volunteer Fire Department Auxiliary and often volunteered at the Prince William County Animal Shelter. Her love of animals is evident as she fostered and adopted over 8 cats and 4 dogs from the shelter.

A funeral is scheduled for February 9th, 2021 at 12 PM. Due to COVID-19 Restrictions the Funeral will be private. Fr. Nectarios of ROC The Holy Innocents & St. Nina Equal-To-the-Apostles will officiate the funeral service. "Here she comes!"

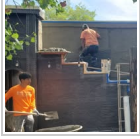

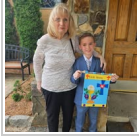
