Margaret Florence (Skelton) Smith, 85, of Gainesville, VA passed away on Thursday, February 16, 2023, surrounded by her family after a long battle with dementia.

Margaret was born and raised in Lincolnshire, England, the daughter of Henry and Gwendoline Skelton. Growing up on a farm in the Lincolnshire countryside gave her a love and appreciation for the outdoors, animals, gardening and a rainy English day.

She met her husband of 63 years, Leonard, on their school bus when they were adolescents. They married in 1960 and eventually decided to move with their young sons, Paul and Stuart, to the United States. After a brief stay in Montreal, Canada, they settled in Springfield, Virginia in 1967 and eventually added their daughter Sarah to the family.

Margaret dedicated her life to her most important roles of Mother and Grandmother. She volunteered in her children's schools, led their scouting groups and imparted the value of giving to others through her endless support of family and friends. After raising her children in Springfield and then Fairfax Station, she enjoyed traveling with Leonard; often spending time in England in the home they built when they were first married, her treasured Bungalow. She maintained lifelong friendships with many people. Most days, you would

find her in her garden, crafting gifts, chatting with friends over a good cup of tea or watching her favorite Liverpool football team.

In addition to her parents, she is predeceased by her beloved granddaughter, Nicole Alexandra Smith.

She is survived by her husband, Leonard; her brother, Derick Skelton of Somerset, England; her children, Paul (Sue) Smith, Stuart Smith and Sarah (Mark) Pavlick; her grandchildren, Brian (Kat), Emily, Christopher, Melanie and Rachel; and her great-grandchildren, Ethan, Madison, Samantha and Cameron.
