MARJORIE D. COULTER of Manassas, Virginia died Thursday, November 27, 2003 at Prince William Hospital, Manassas.

Mrs. Coulter was a member of Westover Baptist Church, Manassas and had been a longstanding member of First Southern Baptist in Lancaster, California before moving to Manassas.

She was preceded in death by her loving husband of 27 years, Stewart Coulter who died in 1984.
