MARJORIE W. THOMAS, age 88 of Manassas, Virginia passed away Sunday, December 9, 2012 at her residence.

Marjorie was born July 7, 1924 in Richmond, Virginia to the late Beverley and Bella (Ross) Wilkerson. She was a 1942 graduate of Covington High School and a 1944 graduate of Dunsmore Business College. She was an active member of the Covington Baptist Church and the Junior Women's Club. She worked at Woodrow Wilson Rehabilitation Center during World War II and also worked for the Social Security Department from 1953 until her retirement in 1986.

Marjorie was married to Russell L. Thomas April 13, 1949, former superintendent of Manassas Public Schools who passed away August 13, 1991. She was also preceded in death by one sister, Celeste Thacker who died in 2011.

She is survived by her daughter, Beverley, of Woodbridge; one sister, Betsy Fultz of Staunton and one brother, Beverley N. Wilkerson, of Staunton.
