Martin King Kilfeather, age 77 of Haymarket, VA died at Novant Health Prince William Medical Center on Monday, January 5, 2015.

Martin was an avid golfer who had the opportunity to play his favorite course in the world, Royal Portrush Golf Club in Northern Ireland. He was also a lifelong Redskins fan who attended the 1992 Super Bowl in Minneapolis. He was an emerging Washington Nationals fan. He coached Braddock Road Boys Clubs travel soccer for 10 years. In his later years he enjoyed reading, especially life accounts of exploration or World War II. He was a lector at St. Stephens Church in Middleburg. His side ministry was Coats to Go where he and his wife Jeanne collected over 6000 coats in a ten year period and delivered them to Central Union Mission in Washington, DC and So Others May Eat (SOME)

He is survived by his wife Jeanne Harrison Kilfeather; his children Denise Kilfeather Clendenin, Kevin Kilfeather, Gary Kilfeather and Mark Kilfeather; his brother Dr. John Kilfeather and by his grandchildren Connor, Emily and Megan Clendenin; Sean, Kayla, Brian, Collin, Brandon, Brady and Hailey Kilfeather and Tyler and Nathan Worthley.
