Martin "Moose" Munoz passed away Wednesday, July 21, 2021 in Manassas, VA of sudden liver failure. He was 56 years old. He was born in Dell City, Texas on October 11, 1964 and moved to Prince William County in the mid-1980's. He worked at Century Stair Company in Haymarket, VA from 1990 to 2010. After that, he worked directly for its founder, Don Costello, until Don's death exactly four years prior to Moose's. Don and Moose were inseparable, and many see it as no coincidence they died on the same date. They were known far and wide in bars and anywhere fun was to be had and we are comforted to think of them together again. Moose was known as the life of the party: the first to order shots, the one who made sure everyone got home safely, and the first to show up the next morning with mimosas and breakfast sandwiches. He was a natural caregiver. He was always taking care of someone, whether helping with everyday tasks or helping people through injuries and illnesses; you could always count on him to be there when needed and to put a smile on your face. His care extended to plants and animals. He had a knack for keeping plants happy and loved all animals, but especially his snakes. He also loved his motorcycle and attending various bike weeks. He leaves behind blood family in Texas: a sister, Iliana Chacon; aunts, Rosita Martinez and Rosario Munoz; and many nieces, nephews, and cousins, including Rosie Strange and June Strange. He also leaves behind a large group of people he loved as family, even if no blood was shared. He was a father figure to some, Uncle Moose to others, and a brother to many more.

He never married but had a few significant relationships over the course of his life. He loved and was loved by many people in many ways and will be missed very deeply
