March 30, 1930 - October 13, 2022

Mary Frances Fleming died peacefully at her home in Nokesville, VA, on October 13th, 2022.

Born March 30, 1930, on her family's farm in Nokesville, she was the daughter of Lester and Gladys Flory and lived her entire life in the Nokesville area. After graduating from Nokesville High School, she became a wife and mother.
