Mary Louise Flury, age 90, of Gainesville, VA, formerly of Overland Park, KS, passed away on Tuesday, September 4, 2012.

She was born in Kingsley, Iowa on January 11, 1922 to the late Glen W. and Edna May Hammer. She was raised in Council Bluffs, Iowa and in 1940 graduated from Abraham Lincoln High School.
