Matthew Peter Geene, Jr., 88, of Gainesville, Virginia passed away on July 17 at Lake Manassas Rehabilitation Center, Gainesville, Virginia from Cardiovascular Disease. Matthew was born and raised in Passaic, New Jersey where he graduated from Passaic Senior High School in 1951. He joined the Army in 1953 where he served in the 11th Airborne Division with an honorable discharge. Upon discharge, Matt attended Spartan School of Aeronautics and Technology in Tulsa, Oklahoma.
