



## Michael McCarrick

July 26, 1945 - October 27, 2011

MICHAEL JAMES MCCARRICK, long time Manassas resident, died Thursday Oct.27, 2011 in his winter home in Ocala, Florida at the age of 66, after a long illness of COPD and lung cancer stemming from exposure to Agent Orange while serving as a medic in Long Bin, Vietnam during the Vietnam War. While serving he received the Vietnam Service Medal with Bronze Service Star, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, Good Conduct Medal and the National Defense Service Medal Marksman (Rifle).

Michael was born July 26th, 1945 to Arthur James McCarrick and Ann Mae (Smith) McCarrick of Alexandria, Va. who have preceded him in death. He married Carol Jean McCarrick April 24th, 2004 who survives him along with three children Sean Michael McCarrick of Warrenton, Va., Shannon Leigh Price of Culpeper, Va., and Johnathan Arthur McCarrick of Harpers Ferry, W. Va. Also surviving are three grand children Gage Alexander Nazier, Michael Wayne Price and Autumn Marie Price all of Culpeper, Va.

Funeral services will be Sat. Nov. 5th, 2011 at Noon at Pierce Funeral Home 9609 Center Street in Manassas, Va. 20110. Sam Bittinger will be presiding. The family is receiving friends from 11 am to 12 Noon on Sat. Nov.5th, 2011 and funeral services will follow. Interment will be at National Memorial Park Cemetery 7482 Lee Highway Falls Church, Va.
