



Michael S. Radcliffe

October 14, 1948 - June 11, 2021

Michael “Mike” Sinclair Radcliffe, 72, of Alexandria, Virginia, passed away on June 11, 2021. Mike was born on October 14, 1948, in Oak Ridge, Tennessee, to George and Vada Radcliffe.

Mike lived with his family in Oak Ridge until October of 1964 when his father got a job with the Army Corps of Engineers as a Power Plant Operator at Ft. Peck Dam and they relocated to Ft. Peck, Montana. He graduated from Glasgow High School in Glasgow, Montana in 1966 and Montana State University in 1970 with a bachelors degree in physics. He met Mildred “Millie” Kuki the summer of 1969 and they were married June 17, 1970. The couple moved to Alexandria, Virginia in 1972. He then began his career as a computer programmer with the Federal Government. Their daughter Suzanne “Suzy” came along in 1974. During his 40-year career, he became a section chief. He was a beloved boss and is remembered fondly by his coworkers, long after he retired in 2012.

Mike was a “techie” long before smart phones and personal computers even existed. He almost always had the latest gadget and shared this love with his daughter. He loved to travel, read, watch TV and movies, go on his daily walks, and follow his favorite teams: the Baltimore Orioles, the Tennessee Volunteers (both football and basketball), the Maryland Terrapins (the “Terps”, both football and basketball), and the Washington Football Team. He was also

captain of a bowling team in the Reprobates bowling league.

Michael joins his wife Mildred, his parents, his brother George Robert III, his sisters Connie and Teresa, and his granddaughter Avery. He is survived by his daughter Suzanne; nephews Rahn, Scott, James, Rob, and Jonny; niece Tammy; great nieces Trinity, Tabitha, and Kathryn; great nephew Frankie; and grandsons Kyle and Josh.

A memorial service will be held for Michael at 3:00 PM on Saturday, June 26, 2021, at Pierce Funeral Home, 9609 Center Street, Manassas, Virginia, 20110.
