Michael J. Shamus, 86, passed away July 4, 2022, with his family by his side in Gainesville, VA. He was preceded in death by his loving wife, Annette, of 61 years. He is survived by daughters; Ann M. Shamus and Megan A. Schlitt and her husband, Danny; grandchildren; Daniel and Annette. He was the son of the late Michael, and Helen (Stancavage) Shamus. He was predeceased by; sisters, Anna Houser and Helen Kalbarczyk; brother, Leonard Shamus.

Mike served in the U.S. Navy for 20 years. During his tenure, he served two Vice Presidents of the United States with distinction and was awarded the Meritorious Service Medal by the President of the United States. He was a primary liaison between the Office of the Vice President, the White House, the Department of Defense, the Department of State and numerous other agencies. While at the White House, he also provided support to the Council on International Economic Policy. Mike accompanied the Vice President on several foreign trips with one trip around the world. The latter part of his career was spent working for the General Services Administration and for the Environmental Protection Agency. Mike was well known to make friends wherever he went and became a mentor to countless people throughout his life.

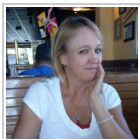
