Miguelito "Mike" Roxas Arevalo, 83, of Fairfax, VA, passed away on December 31, 2025.

Mike was born on May 4, 1942, in Calauan, Laguna, Philippines, to Miguel Arevalo and Luz Roxas Arevalo. He was the second oldest of seven siblings. Mike was working as a contractor for the U.S. government during the Vietnam War when he met the love of his life, Elena "Ellen" Arevalo.
