MILLARD "BLACKIE" CHANCELLOR SEAY, age 84 of Springfield, VA died Tuesday, December 28, 2004 at Inova Fairfax Hospital, Falls Church, VA.

He was a member of the Westwood Baptist Church in Springfield, VA. He was a distinguished veteran of the United States Army Air Corp during World War II.
