MILLER ROBERT WHETZEL, age 82 of Manassas, Virginia died Monday, May 9, 2005 at Prince William Hospital, Manassas.

Mr. Whetzel was a charter member of the Manassas VFW, member of the Masons, and a U.S. Marine Veteran of World War II. In addition, he served with the 92nd AFA during the Korean Conflict and was a Civil War Historian.
