Please walk beside him in heaven Slimbo, he is with you now. His Aunt Becky, Aunt Sue, and Aunt Wilma watched Nicky’s love for them grow as he grew into the fine young man he became. We all had kids before and after Nicky. Nicky was blessed with “his own family” of cousins: Jessie, Jeff, Kayla, Curtis, Joseph, Holly, Kimmie (his fav), Madison, Matthew and Justin. The Parsons’ Thing was created and the pack was formed. Over the years the bonds grew and we all became known as the Parsons’ Gang and Nic was a center of it for us all. He was the second of four sons and as a child he always looked out for brothers; he continued to do so as they all grew; and now he will be looking down on us all from Heaven. Nic was a wonderful grandson; had special relationship with each one of his grandparents; Grandma Thornton, Grandpa Bergman, gMA Judy, gPA Paul

and Ed and Helen Ceppa. He loved them all.

Nic was a freshman football player and Sophomore Shot Putter for this spring track team at Battlefield High School. He was a 1st class boy scout, scholar student and an avid swimmer. He completed level 3 lifeguard training in the waters of Ocean City Maryland where he spent each summer for the last ten years, He rode quads on the RT 15 property, shot hoops in the driveway and launched himself off the jump rock into the pool and made massive tidal waves and splashes. Nic searched and found Christ in his 16th year and was baptized a Christian at Park Valley Church last year. He loved going to Vertical youth ministry and developing his own personal relationship with Christ.
