April 7, 1928 - April 27, 2015

LTC Norman J. Bacon (Ret.) of Gainesville, Virginia, died Monday, April 27, 2015, at Manassas Health and Rehab Center. He was born April 7, 1928, in Baltimore, Maryland to Thomas Bacon and Margaret Bacon. In addition to his parents, he was the youngest of eleven children raised in Essex, Maryland. He became an accountant in Baltimore, Maryland until he was drafted into the United States Army where he became an Army Intelligence Officer. He served in the Korean Conflict and the Vietnam Conflict before retiring in 1972 with 20 years of service. Survivors include his devoted wife, Angie M. Bacon, son James T. Bacon (Julie) and daughter Cheryl Marie Krouss (Kurt); grandchildren, Adam Bacon, Lindsay Krouss, Mitchell Krouss and Nathaniel Krouss.

Norman was a loving, devoted husband and father who provided great spiritual and inspirational strength to his family. He held true to his beliefs and imparted wisdom, humility, and good judgment to his family by word and example. He touched many lives with his friendship and discipleship, serving approximately 30 years as a Bible teacher in the Chuck Colson Prison Ministry Fellowship at the Fairfax County Detention Center. He loved the Bible, especially biblical prophecy, was a prayer warrior, and always had a positive approach to life regardless of circumstances. He was greatly loved and his passing leaves an immeasurable void in the lives of his family, but we know we shall see him in Glory. He shall truly be missed by all who knew him.

A Celebration of Life Service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 28, 2015, at Immanuel Bible Church located at 6911 Braddock Road, Springfield, Virginia 22151.
