Norman Fernand Conde, 88, of Manassas went to see the Lord and join his late wife Josephine on Sunday April 16, while surrounded by loved ones in his home.

Mr. Conde was born in Providence, R.I. on April 27, 1934, the son of the late Urban and Gertrude Conde. He married Josephine Dowe on December 23, 1954 and after moving to Manassas, joined All Saints Catholic Church. He was a proud member of The Knights of Columbus, receiving many awards.

He was preceded in death by wife Josephine J. Conde, daughter Carol J. Conde, sisters Jeanette Cabral, and MaryLou Rothfuss and brother Donald Conde. He is survived by his two sons Urban R. Conde and Steven Conde and Stevens wife Krista Conde. He has three grandchildren, Matthew Conde, Brian Conde, and Sarah Woodard, four great grandchildren, Isaiah Conde, Mati Conde, Averie Conde, and Libby Conde, along with his brother Edmund Conde, and sister Elaine Bruce.

Mr. Conde enlisted in the Air Force in 1953 and served four years before receiving an appointment to West Point Military Academy, that he declined. After He and Josephine married, he attended Bryant College in Providence, R.I. where he graduated with his bachelor's degree in finance.

Mr. Conde joined the C.I.A in The Financial Management Department where he spent 33 years. After retiring from the C.I.A. he began to work for The State Department as an Embassy Security Assessor, and then worked with the N.R.O. in the finance department.

Norman loved to cook, and many weekends could be found cooking for The Knights of Columbus in Manassas. He also enjoyed officiating soccer for league, high school, and national championship games, and was inducted into the Virginia Intercollegiate Soccer Officials Associations Hall of Fame in 2005. He loved to travel the world and was fortunate to have visited, worked and/or lived in at least 74 countries. He loved to travel with his wife Josephine, as they took up to 10 trips yearly.
