Norman Frizzle, Jr., loving father and grandfather, passed away on March 14, 2012.

He was born on December 2, 1929 in Nova Scotia, Canada to the late Norman and Daisy Frizzle. He was a resident in Acton & Concord, MA for 43 years (1930-1973) and since has resided in the Manassas/Bristow area for 39 years (1973-2012). Norman was a member of All Saints Catholic Church from 1973-2002 and Holy Trinity Catholic Church from 2002-2012.

Norman served his country in the U.S. Air Force and in the Korean War. He was honorably discharged from the Air Force in 1955. He was retired from IBM and also served many years as a Prince William Hospital Auxiliary Volunteer. Norman was affectionately known as "Senior Chief Frizzle" to friends in the Nokesville area and will be missed by many.
