October 14, 1917 - April 22, 2007

OTIS WILLIAM LEDBETTER, SR., age 89 of Bristow, Virginia died Sunday, April 22, 2007 at Consulate Health Care, Woodstock, Virginia.

He was born October 14, 1917 in Piedmont, Alabama, the son of the late Malcomb and Cuba Ledbetter.
