After a long and valiant fight against recurring cancer, Pamela Carol Palisin passed on peacefully on June 5th, 2019, in her own bed and surrounded by her family and friends.

Pam was born in 1964 in Cleveland, Ohio, to the late Janice and John Kucharski. She attended Rocky River High School, graduating in 1982 before serving in the U. S. Coast Guard. After marrying her beloved husband in 1987, she continued her service as the proud, steadfast wife of a submarine officer in the U.S. Navy. After extensive travels in service to our country, her final move to Manassas, Virginia occurred in 2005.

She is survived by her husband, Robert Ervin Palisin II, and her two children, Paige Caroline Palisin and Robert Ervin Palisin III.

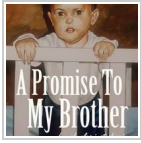
