Patricia Lou Benedict (Patti), age 79, of Bristow, Virginia, passed into her heavenly home on August 30, 2020. Patricia was born to Earl and Lena Simpson in West Virginia on June 1, 1941. From humble beginnings as a coal miner's daughter, Patti was the oldest of nine children. She lovingly helped care for her younger siblings.

Patti had a thriving career in the United States Federal Government. She worked most of her career at the Pentagon as the Director of Resource Management. In 1984, Patti followed the Lord's lead, and took a job in Fulda, West Germany. While there she traveled extensively throughout Europe. She retired from the government in 2000, with countless awards and accolades. After retirement, Patti became a dedicated servant of the Lord volunteering endlessly at Manassas Assembly of God church. She served as a Sunday School teacher, Singles Ministry leader, Alpha ministry volunteer, and ministering at the Prince William County Fair as a puppeteer through the church's ministry there.
