Patricia Louise Hartneady Kniseley passed away on 29 July 2021 at INOVA Fairfax. Daughter of James Patrick and Altha nee Akins Hartneady, Mrs. Kniseley was born on 22 April 1937 in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania and had been a resident of Manassas, Virginia since 1972. Upon her 1955 graduation from Butler High School in NJ, Mrs. Kniseley attended Sherwood Business school. Upon her graduation, she proudly served her country in the CIA until 1965. Upon returning to work in the early 1980s, Mrs. Kniseley again chose service and mission, working for the Prince William County Police Department until her retirement in 2012. Mrs. Kniseley loved reading, tennis, puzzles, and travel, especially her time living with her husband and daughters in Germany in the 1970's. She especially enjoyed any activity in which her grandkids were involved.
