Patricia Ann Wolfe Smith passed away in her sleep on January 12, 2019 in Warrenton, VA. She was born on May 21st, 1933 to Ann Elizabeth Wolfe and James Wolfe in Wheatland, PA. She grew up in Farrell, PA where she went to and graduated from Farrell High School. There she met Paul Frederick Smith who she married December 26, 1951. Patricia traveled with him to Biloxi, Mississippi as he was in the Coast Guard. This began a lifetime of travel as Pat and Paul would move all over the world with Paul in the Coast Guard, then in the Central Intelligence Agency. They would live in England, Warrenton, Virginia, Miami, Florida, Taipei, Taiwan, Seoul, Korea and finally, Manassas, Virginia. It was in Taipei that their only son Jerry was born in 1962. After moving to Manassas, Pat took a job at All Saints Catholic School as the part-time librarian assistant. Little did she realize that this would lead to 30-year career at the school. From librarian she received the training to become a full-time teacher at the school. Over the years she would be a 1st grade, 2nd grade and 3rd grade teacher. Pat then moved on to become the computer teacher as technology moved into the school. She was able to touch the lives of all the children in the school and gave them an introduction to computers through programing and applications.

Also, during this time she became involved with Jerry's schools (Flint Hill and George Mason) by supporting the basketball programs. She attended the games and took pictures, using them to create scrapbooks for the coaches and players. These keepsakes have become of the most treasured

belongings of the recipients. Other hobbies she enjoyed were attending concerts, cooking, shopping, and watching her grandchildren do anything. Pat is survived by her son Jerry, his wife Linda, grandsons Alex and David, her sister Marilyn Wolfe and brother Gerald Wolfe.
