PAUL PHILLIP DIEHL, age 93, of Arlington, Virginia, died Friday, February 20, 2004, at Arlington Hospital, Arlington, Virginia.

Mr. Diehl moved to Arlington County from Prince William County in 1936. He was a member of the Arlington Church of the Brethren. Mr. Diehl was a former dairy farmer and later worked at Thompson's Dairy in Washington, D.C. Later, upon retiring, he became a self-employed painter and repair contractor.

He was preceded in death by his wife of over 67 years, Jeannette Matthews Diehl, in 2003; one son, Stanley Diehl, in 1938; two brothers, Roy Diehl, William Amos Diehl, and one sister, Hazel Virginia Keys.
