Pauline Wampler Shortridge, 88, of Millsboro, Del., and formerly of Manassas, Va., passed away Wednesday, June 27, 2018, after a brief illness at the Delaware Hospice Center, Milford, Del.

She was born July 30, 1929, in Buchanan County, Va. She retired from Piedmont Federal Savings Bank as a senior loan officer, and previously worked for Birmingham Dairy.
