October 13, 1998 - February 10, 2016

As some of you already know, we lost our baby, Payton Rose, on February 10, 2016.

Payton was a smart, funny, beautiful girl, whose life was cut short by the effects of bullying. She loved life, but in the end, the bullying was too much for her heart to handle.

We all have a responsibility to make sure that no one else is made to feel the way that Payton did. We must guard our actions and be thoughtful in the way we treat one another:

"Watch your thoughts, they become words. Watch your words, they become actions. Watch your actions, they become habits. Watch your habits, they become character. Watch your character for it becomes your destiny." – Frank Outlaw

Here are four things you can do right this minute that can make a difference:
Check your child's phone and social media use on a regular and consistent basis

Talk to your children about the importance of kindness and doing what they know is right - regardless of outside influences

Be present. At home, at school, at activities.

Don't be afraid to speak up - to parents, teachers and administrators, and other adults in positions of influence. One person can make the ultimate difference when it comes to preventing bullying.

If you see something or hear something, please, say something! And if you are being bullied, there is hope. Please reach out to someone you love and ask them to stand by you.

When we are strong, it is our duty to stand up for others, no matter how difficult. We should live our lives "dauntlessly" as author Veronica Roth writes:

"We believe in...denying fear the power to influence our decisions. We believe in ordinary acts of bravery. In the courage that drives one person to stand up for another. We believe in shouting for those who can only whisper. In defending those who cannot defend themselves."

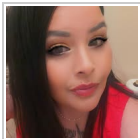

The only thing we truly have in life is the love in our hearts and those who love us. In the end that is the only thing we will have or be able to take with us. And although these ideas will be fresh in your mind for many weeks to come life has a funny way of dragging you back down in to the daily grind. Always remember Payton, and always remember to be kind and to help others when you can, try to remember to appreciate every moment when you can and be grateful for what ever it is you have. To Brent and his family, my heart is broken for you! Brent, I could not talk to you last night through the tears and pain I feel for you. A girl as amazing as Payton can only be a product of loving and caring parents, you are an amazing father and you will always will be. You have done your job and will continue to do so. This is not something that will get easier in time or go away,

but you will learn to incorporate it into your life and in time you will learn to live focusing more on the love than the pain. She is with you always, love cannot be snuffed like a candle, it burns like the Sun. Be well my friend, we are all here for you and your family.

“ I wanted to write to all of you what i would have said at Payton's Service last night, "Warning, Long Winded message"
My name is Keith, I worked with Payton's Father for several years and although I never met Payton in person I want to tell you how she was able to impact my life. Back in 2003 I started to work with Brent, it was my first real job, I was saving up to be able to marry my then girlfriend and I was also struggling to figure out how to the job I was hired for. One day Brent and I were alone in the Server room and we started to talk about family, Brent told me about his wife and her two children that he has loved as his own and then he talked about Payton. He talked about the day she was born and the feelings he had as he was pushing her in a cart to the room where Payton and her mother would be spending the night. He explained the impact and immediate love he had for her and he would make sure no one would ever hurt her, it was powerful how he explained this moment. On Brent's desk was a picture of him and Payton, it was one of the pictures displayed in the lobby showing Payton as a young girl hugging check to check with Brent looking at the camera. Seeing that picture after the conversation I had with Brent was the first time that the concept of parenthood was not frightening to me and I honestly looked at the picture every day that Brent and I worked at that location. When my first child was born and we found out she was a girl so many thoughts were speeding through my head, but the image of that picture and what Brent said to me was one of the more vivid thoughts. When I was wheeling my daughter to the room where her and my wife would be spending the night I repeated the same words that Brent had told me, "I will never let anyone hurt you!" But our ideas about how life is going to be and how it actually is are always very different. To you, Payton's friends and school mates, I want to share some insight and wisdom about life. I listened to many of you say that you wished you had made the opportunity to know her better, or you wished you had pressed her more about anything that may have been bothering her, what I am hearing is many of you in your own way are blaming yourself for what happened. Listen to me, this is not your fault, you were all friends with her, you all were there for her in your own way and to

the best of your ability at that given moment. Life is busy, its chaotic and at your age with school and preparing for the real world after graduation, you guys do not know what way is up or down. You are all angry inside, you are angry at the situation, you are angry at God and deep down inside you are angry at Payton! How could this girl who has the world going for her have this happen? There is going to be a lot of speculation as to why, but in reality only two people know the true reason why, Payton and God. As a person who has struggled with major depression my entire life I can only tell you that when you reach your limit all thoughts of logic and reason are gone. And I am not saying depression was the cause of this, I do not know, and no matter how much you all demand to know the answer to this question it still will never make sense. For those of you who believe in God, you want to shake your fist at him and ask him, "How could you let this happen?!" God gave us all freewill, the will to believe in him or not, the will to be good or be evil, the will to dedicate your life to helping others or lookout for yourself. Many say that this concept of freewill is the ultimate test from God to see if we are worthy of him, so did Payton Pass or Fail this test? Based on what I heard during the service, she constantly went out of her way to make her friends and total strangers happy, she was an involved person in learning and out going, she stood up for anyone she felt was being wronged, and she loved! 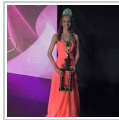
