



Peggy Pauline Weber Marshall

February 14, 1926 - October 28, 2023

Peggy Pauline Weber Marshall passed away on October 28, 2023, at her home in Catharpin, Virginia. Peggy was 97 years old.

Peggy is survived by her sister Dorothy Pearson, her 5 children Wanda Westmoreland, Shelby Montgomery, Dennis Weber, Steven Weber, and Jerry Weber; Her grandchildren Michael Westmoreland, Kelly Westmoreland, Dustin Weber, Maya Weber, Kira Lake, and Jeyda Weber. As well as lots of great grandchildren!

Peggy was born on February 14th, 1926, in Centreville, VA to Harvey L. Nichols and Olive Nichols. She spent most of her time playing with her older brother Eldred and hiding from her sister Dorothy whom they considered too young to play with them. Peggy was not fond of school and would often hide under her bed all day to avoid going.

At the age of 18, Peggy started working at Payne's Store in Centreville, VA where she met her first husband Walton. Walton worked at the Library of Congress and would stop at the store on his way to and from work to see Peggy. Walton and Peggy got Married in 1950 and had 5 wonderful children. Peggy is preceded in death by her husband Walton of 33 years who passed away on February 17th, 1983.

Peggy was considered a pillar in the Manassas Church of Christ for many

years. She was baptized on July 3rd, 1977. She rarely missed a Sunday and had a reserved row on the left down the center aisle with all her close friends and grandson Dustin.

Peggy started driving a school bus for Prince William County in 1968. The mechanics put wood blocks on both pedals of the bus for Peggy to be able to reach them. She received numerous safe driving awards and thankful letters from parents. Peggy was fortunate to be able to drive her sons Steve and Jerry to school. As well as her grandson Dustin. Peggy drove for over 30 years, retiring in 1998.

Even after retirement Peggy still loved to remain active. She would teach exercise classes at the Senior Center in Manassas, Virginia. She loved to play Mahjong Tiles on her computer. If it was 7PM Peggy would be watching Wheel of Fortune and Jeopardy. Her son Steven Weber took Peggy, Dorothy, and Dustin on vacation together to the Grand Canyon, Disney World and Pigeon Forge.

Peggy remarried at the age of 87 to Orval Marshall on February 14th, 2013. This day quickly became known as the Trifecta: Peggy's Birthday, Wedding Anniversary, and Valentine's Day. Both Peggy and Orval were active members of the Manassas Church of Christ and Senior Center. They absolutely loved the Sweetheart Dinner at Church every year. They took Bluebird tours to both Branson, MO and Nashville, TN. Orval passed away last year on March 20th, 2022.

Peggy was still very active in her 97th year, walking two days a week at the Manassas mall with her daughter Wanda and Son-in-Law Larry. Her daughter Shelby would take her weekly for shopping trips or hair appointments.

Peggy was reserved and sometimes quiet, but she could effortlessly make

anyone laugh. She had a quick wit and a sarcastic sense of humor. Most Sunday family dinners she would have the table laughing at a silly joke or quirky remark. She loved to smile and share everything she had with those close to her.

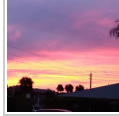
