PETER ZROWKA, age 79, passed away on December 12, 2014 at his home in Centreville, VA.

He was born on July 4, 1935 in Simpson, PA to the late Hnatko and Paraska (Kuzmiak) Zrowka. Mr. Zrowka worked for the CIA for 29 years, after retirement he started up his own business Life Support Services, Inc. contracting with the government. He received numerous awards including a Purple Heart and the Intelligence Medal.
