



## Philip Arvid Langehough

June 23, 1924 - June 3, 2017

Philip Arvid Langehough, age 92, passed away on Saturday, June 3, 2017 in Manassas, Virginia.

Phil was born on June 23, 1924 in Spring Valley, MN the second child of the late Rev and Mrs. O. Milford Langehough. He graduated from St. Olaf College in Northfield, Minnesota with a BA Degree in 1948. He attended the University of Minnesota graduating from the Hubert Humphry Institute with a MA Degree in 1952. Mr. Langehough was employed by the Bureau of the Budget from 1955 – 1972 and the Office of Management and Budget from 1972 – 1978. He taught an Adult Bible Class from 1959-2004 and was the Program Director for Lutheran Lay Fellowship from 1984 – 2005. Phil married Emily Jane Davy on April 14, 1956 at Luther Place in Washington, D.C. and enjoyed 49 years of marriage.

He is predeceased by his parents; his loving wife; his son: Mark Philip Langehough and his sister: Inez Tabberson.
