



## Phillip Griebel

August 11, 1924 - May 4, 2013

Phillip M. Griebel, 88, husband of the late Lucille M. (Jones) Griebel, of Centreville, VA passed away on Saturday, May 4, 2013, in the Pottstown Memorial Medical Center. Born in Little River, Kansas, he was a son of the late George P. and Franklyn (Cummings) Griebel.

He had been a member of the Centreville United Methodist Church in Centreville, VA and a member of the Free and Accepted Masons. He attended Hutchinson Junior College and Wichita State University prior to his enlistment in the US Navy, where he served in the Pacific during World War II. Phillip retired in 1975 as a Coast Guard Commander after 29 years of service. He was also a 35 year member of AA.

Mr. Griebel is survived by his children, George P., husband of Karen Griebel, of Herndon, VA, Catherine L. Griebel, of Troy, PA, and Marcia P.
