Rachella Rhudy Pippin, age 72, passed away on Saturday, November 10, 2018 at her home in Manassas, Virginia.

During her courageous five-year battle with breast cancer she relied heavily on her Faith in her Lord Jesus Christ to get her through. She was always sharing that faith with those she met and always telling people she would be praying for them.

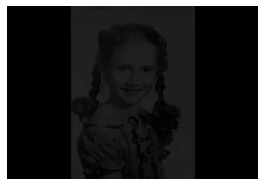
