May 9, 1934 - September 8, 2014

Ray Lee Hill passed away on September 8, 2014 after a number of years suffering from the effects of Alzheimer's. He resided in Bristow, VA with his wife Mary Lee.

Ray was born in McGill, NV on May 9, 1934. His family moved to Utah shortly after where he loved to play in the mountains hunting, fishing in cool mountain lakes and streams and hiking. He served a 2 year mission for his church, then was drafted into service into the Army for another 2 years during the Korean War and spent time in basic training in Washington State. He then served in Augusta, GA in the Signal Corps. After finishing his education at Brigham Young University, he and his family moved to Virginia where he worked for the Federal Government as a Procurement Analyst.

Ray is survived by in addition to his wife Mary Lee by four children Janet, Boyd, Kathryn and Ruth and was preceded in death by another child Bruce. He has eight grandchildren Jason, Joshua, Jacqueline, Daniel, Mark, Jocelyn, Blake and Brent. He left behind his brothers Max and Ned and his sister Barbara Ruth Laws and was preceded in death by two sisters Fern and Arva.

His family will miss him and his ability to bring others to the Gospel of the Savior. Many called him blessed. He was a great scribe.
