Renate Katharina (Schreiber) Bibeau, formerly of Manassas, Virginia passed away peacefully on Sunday, November 26, 2023, in Grand Rapids, Minnesota. She was the widow of Howard Harley Bibeau and celebrated 65 years of marriage until his death in 2021. She was born on March 23, 1939, in Wiesbaden, Germany, daughter of the late Herta (Schreiber) Johnson and Heinrich Anton Schreiber. She was also preceded in death by her stepfathers Johann Glockler and Hugo Waldemar Johnson, and her daughter-in-law Vicki Lynn Bibeau.

Renate is survived by her three children: Frank Bibeau of Grand Rapids, Minnesota; Cole Bibeau (Cathy) of Sumter, SC; and Kimberly (Wiseman) Bibb (Mark) of Manassas. 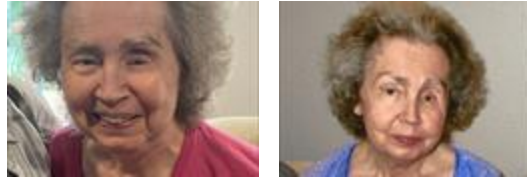
