Reves F. Childress, 92, of Warrenton, VA, went home to be with His Lord, Friday, November 20, 2015, from Fauquier Hospital, Warrenton, VA.

A son of the late Mary Belle (McGlothlin) and John Bryan Childress, Reves was born in Skeggs, Buchanan County, VA. He moved with his family to Northern Virginia in 1941.

Reves served his country in the U.S. Navy during World War II and later in the U.S. Army. Afterward, he took up carpentry and worked in the construction industry until he retired. He was a fine craftsman.

Friends and family were always important to Reves. He kept in touch with his military buddies, often visited relatives in Southwest Virginia, and loved getting family together to eat and talk. His green thumb yielded an abundance of vegetables and flowers that he shared. It tickled him to get a joke on you.
